Pre-school Admissions Policy for September 2023

This Admissions Policy is in place to ensure parents/carers and staff understand the process for the allocation of places at Woodford Primary School Pre-school.

We offer Pre-school provision for children in the academic year before they start school.

The Laurus Trust is the Admissions Authority for places at Woodford Pre-school.

At Woodford Pre-school we offer full and part time places and will where possible, accommodate parental requests for their preferred pattern. Woodford Pre-school is registered to care for children by Ofsted, under the Early Years Welfare Requirements.

Eligible parents are entitled to 15 or 30 hours free childcare. This funding is intended to support working parents with the cost of childcare and to enable parents, where they wish, to return to work or to work additional hours.

How do I apply for a place at Woodford Pre-school?

An online application form is on the Starting Preschool page of the school website

Application forms to be submitted between July and December 2022

Places will be offered week by end of March 2023 and parents/carers will be sent an agreement with confirmed pattern

Parent/carer retun Agreement and all other documents by end of June to confirm place

Applications

- Pre-school applications can be made from 25th July 2022 to 31st December 2022 using the online form on the Starting Pre-school page of the school website.
- Offers will be made by the end of March 2023 for the following September start.
- Places will be allocated using the following priority order:
 - A Children of staff employed by the Laurus Trust
 - B Children with siblings in attendance at Woodford Primary School

C Distance (measured in a straight line from Woodford Primary School to the child's home address)

- Places will be offered on an availability basis, reflecting the sessions requested.
- If we are unable to meet your request in full, alternative sessions will be offered if available.
- Places are secured with the return of a Pre-school Agreement and all other required documents.
- If the alternatives offered are not suitable, you will be given the option of joining the waiting list.
- The waiting list is reviewed on a regular basis and places are offered/allocated as soon as they become available.

Please be aware that a place at Woodford Pre-school **does not** guarantee a place at Woodford Primary School. School admissions are arranged through Stockport Local Authority. For more information please clink on the <u>link</u>.

When there is more than one child on our waiting list, the following over subscription criteria will be used:

- A Children of staff employed by the Laurus Trust
- **B** Children with siblings in attendance at Woodford Primary School

Appeals

Parents and Carers have a right to appeal against any decision regarding admission to Woodford Pre-school.

All appeals will be heard by a panel within 40 school days of receiving an appeal.
