Assessment and Reporting

The assessment of pupil progress is a daily ongoing process and happens predominantly through the work the children are doing in class and the conversations we have with them which allow Class Teachers to adapt their teaching to ensure it is always as targeted as possible. At three points over the academic year, we also do a round of assessments to provide some additional information which informs our assessment of pupils' respective levels of attainment. As in previous terms, we will be sending out current teacher assessment judgements for Reception and Year 1 to provide you with a snapshot of how your child is currently progressing in relation to the nationally set expectations for their year group.

Parents' Evening

It was great to see everybody at last week's Parents' Evening appointments. We hope that you found these meetings useful and enjoyed the opportunity to speak with your child's Class Teacher about their current strengths and the next steps that have been identified for them. We really value working in partnership with parents/carers, so thank you for making the time to come into school and for the ongoing support you provide at home.

Reading Over Easter

As we approach a two week break from school, the main message as always is to ensure your child is experiencing regular reading opportunities.



Reading to them is excellent for modelling reading fluency, as is sharing a book, but any regular slots of reading down-time are beneficial. Remember there are lots of different ways to have fun with reading over the break and a visit to a local library is always worthwhile.
