Updated Behaviour Policy

We have already shared a few details with you regarding the updated Laurus Trust Primary Behaviour Policy. This week in assembly, we shared this with the children and explained how the communication with parents and carers would work. We also set out the expectation of the children explaining to you at home why a behaviour message had been sent.

Whilst the policy will not change much of our current approach in school, it is important to highlight the main aims which are:

- to encourage the children to take responsibility for, and to reflect on, their behaviour in school;
 and
- to be more systematic and timely in the way we share behaviour incidents with parents/carers.

We are hopeful that the updates will allow us to work collaboratively together with families, to support the children should behaviours persist over time.
